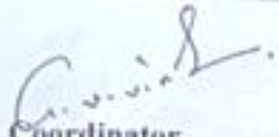
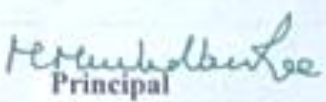
4. Feedback from Participants
