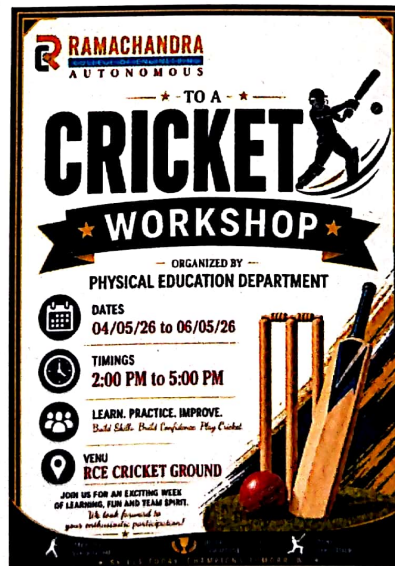


**Report on 3 days workshop on “MEN’S CRICKET WORKSHOP ” organized by
